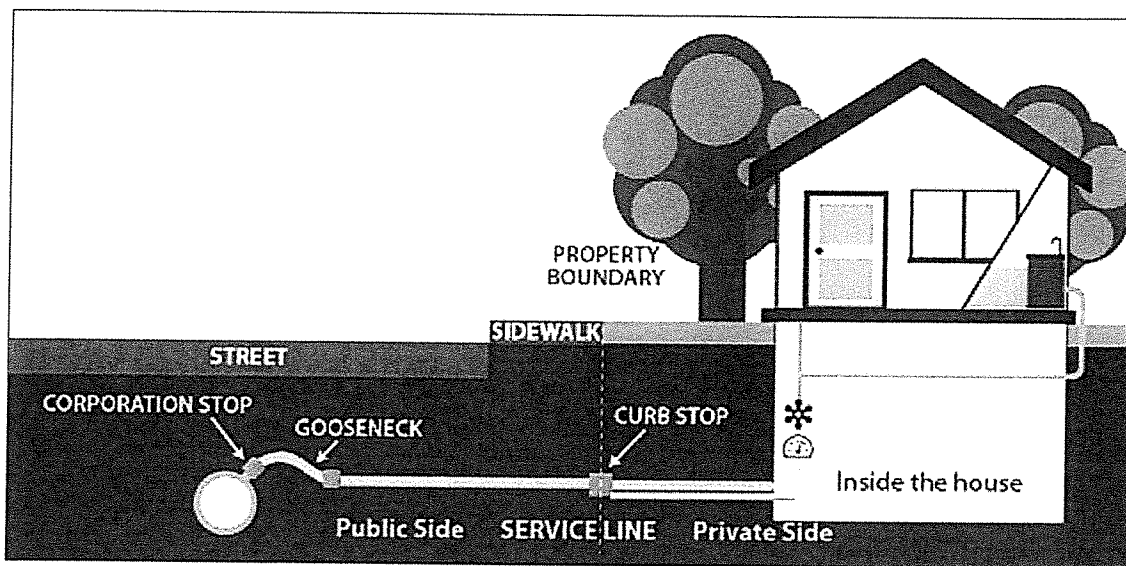


What are the Parts of a Service Line?

The Lead Service Line Inventory requires identification of both the public (utility owned) and private (customer owned) sides of the service line. If either line is lead or galvanized that was or is downstream of lead, then there are additional steps that need to be taken. This inventory must be completed by October 16, 2024. The goal is to have an accurate inventory by that time.
